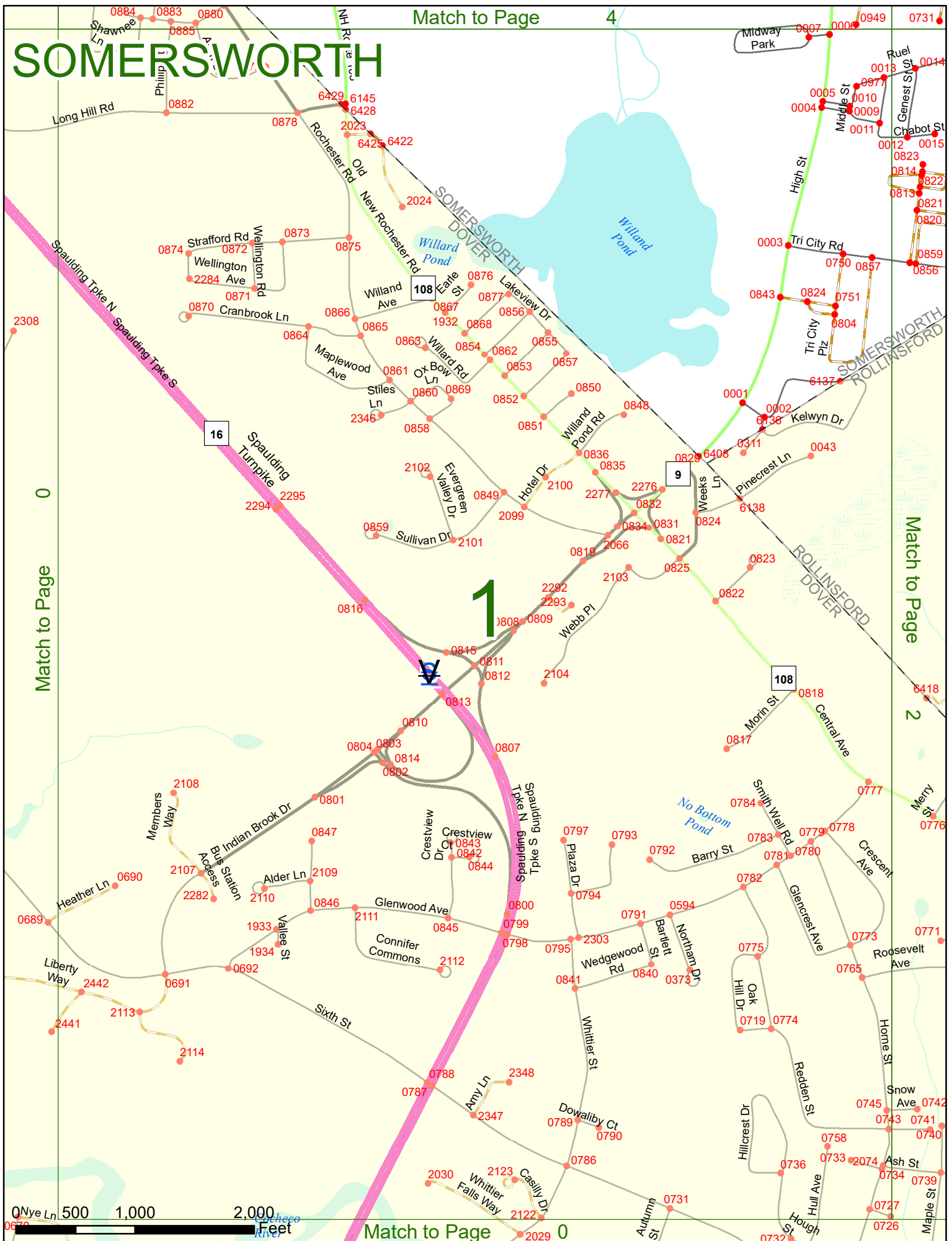


SOMERSWORTH

The map displays the town of Somersworth, Maine, and its surrounding areas. Key features include:

- Geography:** The town is situated along the coast of Maine, with Coles Pond and Willow Pond visible. The border with New Hampshire is to the south, and the border with Canada is to the north.
